ABS e-Certificate Validation Instructions

ABS e-Certificates, fully compliant with IMO Guidelines, will reduce administrative burdens and simplify Flag State verification.

ABS has established a public site **ABS MYFREEDOM™CLIENT PORTAL** where anyone can look up and validate any ABS e-Certificate following IMO FAL.5 Circ.39/Rev. 2 requirements, either by the vessel IMO number or the certificate number or class number.

PUBLIC ACCESS FOR QUICK VALIDATION OF E-CERTIFICATES

The authenticity, originality and traceability of the e-Certificates are easily verifiable.


How to Validate an e-Certificate


- 1 Go to <u>www.eagle.org</u> or login to ABS MYFREEDOM™CLIENT PORTAL.
- 2 Click on Rules and Resources.






- 3 Click on Databases.
- 4 Click on the Databases E-Certificates.






- 5 Enter the IMO Number or ABS Certificate Number or Class Number.
- 6 Click on Search.


The general certificate information will be displayed, and the certificate history can be chosen to display issuance and endorsement dates. In the event that a certificate is not authentic or valid, an alert message will be displayed.



This verifies that the e-certificate meets IMO FAL.5 Circ.39/Rev.2 requirements and has not been altered since the issuance.



The certificate can also be validated by scanning the QR Code printed on the Certificate. For example, we have provided a blank sample e-certificate for your reference.
